IDEAS

(Note: Although these questions arise from specific sections of the chapter, please allow the whole chapter to possibly supplement your answers.)

List the five names (one of these has an alternate translation which would make six) of the Lord's Supper (including "the Lord's Supper") which KOLB provides.

List the "three kinds of "unity" or "union" that take place in this feast." (*Koinonia* 1, 2, and 3)

List the four similarities between baptism and the Lord's Supper beyond the "definition."

What significance of using bread wine does KOLB highlight? What danger does he suggest need be avoided?"

KOINONIA 1

Discuss the four presuppositions for the "Real Presence."

Discuss the three "defining phrases" for the "Real Presence."

Discuss the four “alternative views.”

Distinguish receptionism from consecrationism.

KOINONIA 2

“Luther objected to any view of what happens in the celebration of the Sacrament as a human opportunity for contribution.” Reflect (in light of Law-Gospel distinction and *sola fide*).

Reflect on the comparison between “one loaf” and “one family.”

Considering Communion Fellowship, relate the two ways people “deceive themselves” with pastoral care and the practice of close communion.

Discuss the three “practical aspects” of coming together for the Lord’s Supper which KOLB highlights.
